ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Hauling brush, mowing and raking.
- Operating power equipment.
- Additional hours may be requested for Garden special events such as Gala, Heritage days, SHINE, etc., which might include evenings.
- Other duties as assigned by the Executive Director.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS REQUIRED:

- High school diploma, or equivalent, preferred.
- Experience working in the natural sciences, horticulture, or arboriculture, preferred.
- A desire to work outdoors performing manual labor in all weather conditions.
- Perform strenuous, hands-on work in *all* types of weather conditions.
- Effectively work and communicate within a team.
- A positive attitude and willingness to learn.
- Willing and able to operate small power equipment.
- Valid driver's license and an acceptable vehicle record.
- Must be able to pass a drug test and undergo a background report.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Must be able to perform with or without reasonable accommodation:

- Perform strenuous, hands-on work year-round in all types of weather conditions (Working outdoors or indoors where the ambient temperature spans 25-100 degrees Fahrenheit).
- Transport oneself by foot over various terrain that may be wet, slippery, uneven, and/or rocky.
- Operate a variety of small machinery and power equipment including utility vehicles, pruners, sheers, weed eaters, sprayers, blowers, and push and riding mowers.
